Afternoon	<p>If mailing, all completed garments and artwork to have arrived to RMIT Textiles, 25 Dawson Street Brunswick, 'The Hub' Bld 514 Lvl 1, marked Attn: Mary Mirt</p> <p>Please note: It is easier if everything is placed together in one bag/suit bag. Please label all garments and related artwork, hangers, etc clearly with designer's name and contact details to ensure correct return.</p> <p>Remember to submit your artwork with the garments (it is not necessary to include the visual diaries).</p> <p>You must include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Short DVD of the garment/outfit on a live model. This is to assist the judges with the 3-dimensional view of the garments on the intended model <p>**If you do not have access to a video recorder a slide show of digital stills of the outfit on the model will be accepted.</p> <p>Please note: it is not expected that students invest in an expensive/professional video production. Just something simple.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A relevant curriculum vitae i.e. one that would enable you to secure a job in the TCF industry. This must be no longer than 2 A4 pages.

5:30pm (for 6pm start)	<p>Finalists to arrive and get themselves ready to stand next to their entry and are prepared to meet trade representatives and audience.</p> <p>All models to get ready to stand next to the artwork display & designer.</p> <p>All competition finalists will receive a complimentary admission ticket to the presentation night for themselves and their model.</p>
6pm – 7:15pm	<p>Refreshments served.</p> <p>Garments will be on display in Building 514 seminar rooms.</p> <p>Audience invited to look at the displayed entries and to choose a winner of the audience prize.</p> <p>Votes are to be written on the official admission tickets.</p>
7:15pm -	<p>Audience ushered into catwalk area and MC to officially welcome audience & to ask audience to cast their prize winning vote.</p> <p>TI members to collect the votes and to collate</p>
	Finalists to gather behind the stage curtains ready for receipt of their certificates (these will be handed out in alphabetical order)
	Last year's Grand Prize winner –to give a small talk about her experience at the Paris American Academy
	Certificates to be presented to all finalists
	Fashion parade to be introduced.
	Models to parade garments and then stand backstage near designer.
